The weather is not beautiful all of the time. Perhaps you can remember a day when the bad weather made you afraid. One kind of the bad weather that scares many people called a thunderstorm. This is what happens when there is a thunderstorm. First you see a sudden flash of bright light. A few seconds later you hear a rumbling sound. This quick flash is called lighting, and the loud sound is called thunder. Lighting is colorful, but can cause serious problem. Lighting is electricity that is moving very rapidly. It may be moving between a cloud and ground, between two clouds or between two parts of the same cloud. The lighting heats the air around it. This hot air expands, or gets bigger, and it causes the air to move in waves. The air waves pass in a series, one after another. For this reason, you may hear many rumbles and just one sound.
